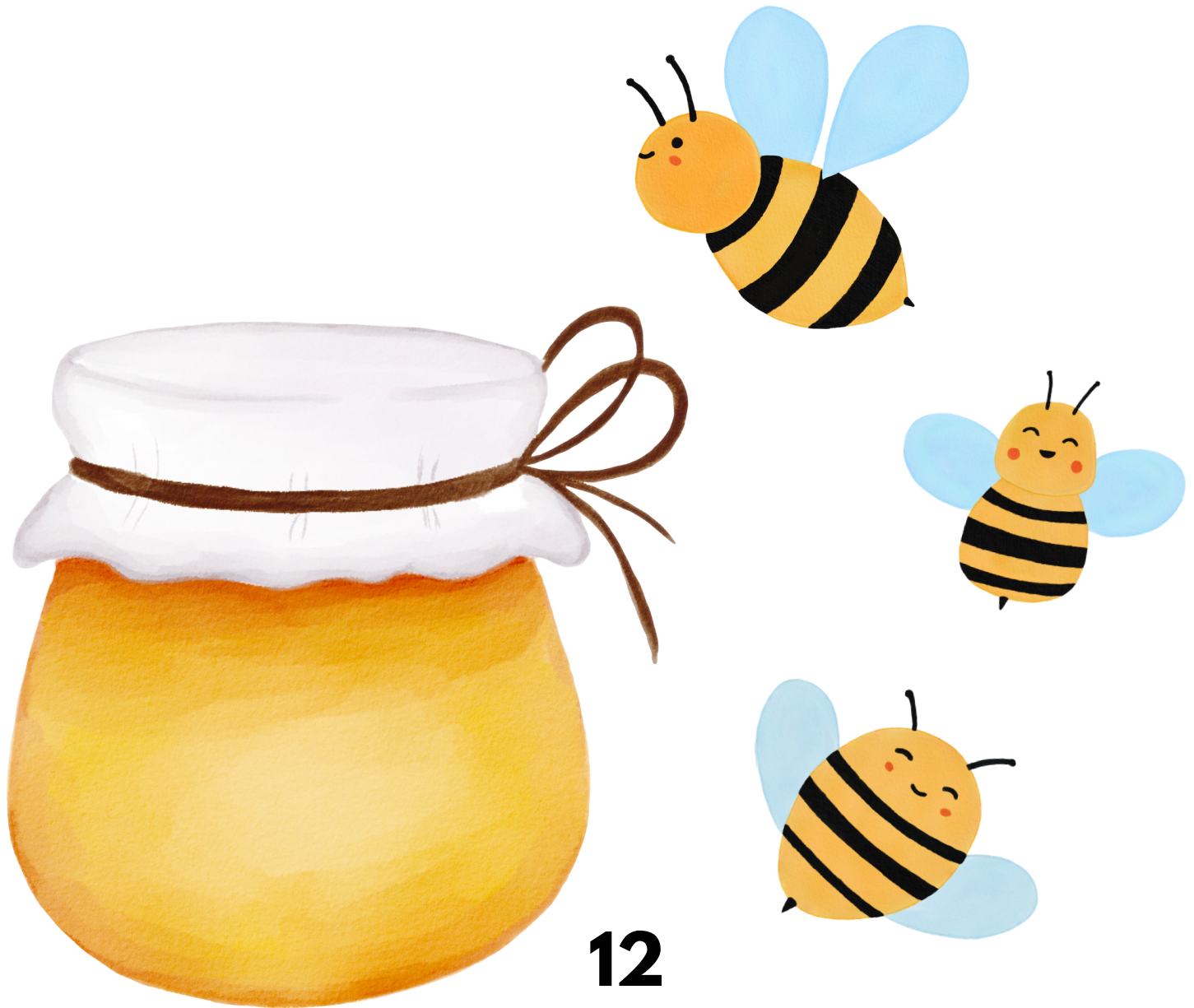


KINLEY TICEHURST

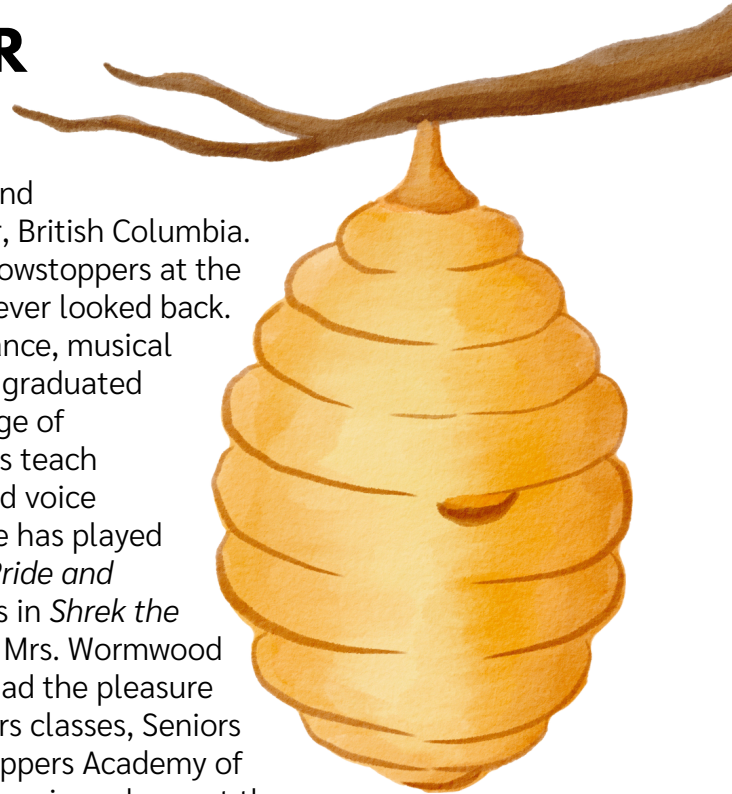
PRODUCTION

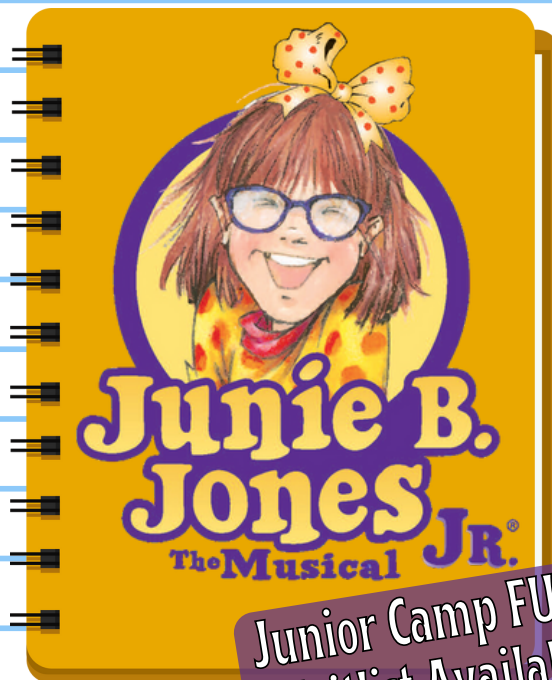

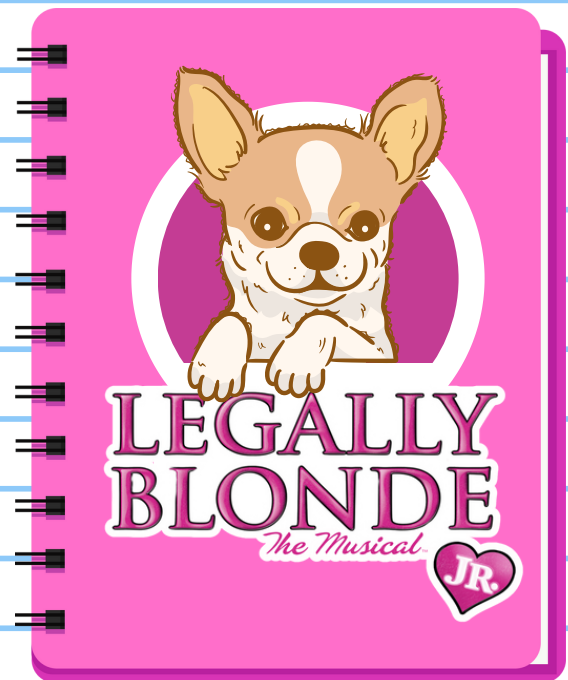
